1. Applications in the prescribed format are invited from applicants who are qualified as on the last date fixed for submission of applications for recruitment to **19 (Nineteen) Posts** of Drivers in Karnataka Urban Water Supply & Drainage Board, Bengaluru. 2. Method of Recruitment: Selection of candidates will be made in accordance with the Karnataka Civil Services (General Recruitment) Rules, 1977 and as amended from time to time.

3. Minimum Qualification:

Must have passed S.S.L.C or equivalent examination and who possess license for driving Heavy/Light Passenger Motor Vehicle or Heavy/Light Goods Vehicle and who have got a minimum of 3 years experience in driving. Further the candidate should have good knowledge of Kannada.

6. Probation: The applicant if appointed shall be initially on probation for a period of two years or for such extended period.

7. Age limit: Applicants must have attained the age of 18 years and must not exceed the age of (as per Rule 6(1) of the Karnataka Civil Services (General Recruitment) Rules, 1977):-

- (a) 40 years in the case of a person belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe and Category-I of other Backward classes.
- (b) 38 years in case of persons belonging to Category-II A, II B, III-A, III-B of other Backward classes and
- (c) 35 years in case of others.

As per Rule 6(3) of the Karnataka Civil Services (General Recruitment) Rules, 1977 Notwithstanding anything contained in Rule 6(1) of the same, the maximum age limit for appointment of a suitable candidate shall be deemed to be enhanced in the following cases to the extent mentioned, namely:-

i. In case of a candidate who is working or holding a post under the Government or local authority or a Corporation established by a State Act or a Central Act or established by the Government under State Act or Central Act and owned or controlled by the Government by the number of years during which he is or was holding such a post or ten years whichever is less

(c) The minimum and maximum age limit will be as on the **last date of submission of application.**

8. Method of Application and fee: The method of Application shall be through **off line and the application form can be down loaded from the website www.kuwdsb.org** and sent through Registered Post or by person along with Xerox copy of fee paid challan.

Applications sent through any mode other than the above will not be considered.

Application Fee:

Mode of Payment:

- (ii) Candidates must produce the fee paid challan at the time of verification of original documents.

9. Criteria for selection:

- 50% weightage will be given to the performance of the Candidates in the Driving test.
- 50% Weightage will be given for previous services in Government Departments, (Permanent/Contract/Outsource) under the Government or a local authority or a Corporation established by a State Act or a Central Act or established by the Government under a State Act or Central Act and owned or controlled by the Government.

10. Candidates Claiming Reservations:

a) The candidates belonging to SC/ ST/OBC, shall possess the certificate in the form as prescribed by the Government of Karnataka, and issued by the competent Authority.

b) The candidates claiming relaxation of upper age limit shall produce relevant certificate issued by the competent authority at the time of verification of documents. A copy of the same should be submitted along with the Application form.

(c) The candidates who are in service of Union of India/State Governments and their undertaking shall possess the **“No Objection Certificate”** issued by the Authority and produce the same at the time of verification of documents/further tests. At the same time they shall specifically mention the number of years of holding of office, for claiming age relaxation.

(d) The candidates claiming benefits under Sl. No. 10 (a) to (c) above shall possess the relevant certificates, issued by the Competent Authorities **on or before the last date of submitting application**. A copy of the certificates should be submitted along with the application form.

11. Candidates claiming weightage due to previous experience on Government Departments/ In case of a candidate who is working or was holding a post (Permanent/Contract/Outsource) under the Government or a local authority or a Corporation established by a State Act or a Central Act or established by the Government under a State Act or Central Act and owned or controlled by the

Government have to submit the experience certificates issued by Competent Authority and the First and Last Salary Certificate issued by the Competent Authority.

12. At the time of Verification of documents, the candidates shall produce the original documents with regard to Educational Qualification, Date of Birth, and reservation if any claimed with regard to Caste or Age relaxation along with certificates issued by the competent authority for verification.

13. Candidates belongs to Hyderabad Karnataka Region must produce the original eligibility certificate in ANNEXURE-A and residential certificate in ANNEXURE-B issued by the Competent Authority of the concerned District/Taluk, at the time of document verification. A copy of the same should be submitted along with the Application form.

14. The candidates shall furnish 3 character certificates (one from the last studied education Institution and 2 from the respectable persons) along with the application form.

15. The candidates called for Driving Test /Interview will have to appear for the same at their own cost.
